Island Experience

The students get the opportunity to visit Lady Elliot Island, an island on the great barrier reef. They get to swim with the turtles and fish, snorkel, learn about the ecology of the area. The students are also offered the opportunity to scuba dive at an extra cost.

Sea turtles are one of the earth's most ancient creatures! Turtles can be seen in the water around Lady Elliot all year round and are a popular sighting with the guests. Turtle nesting & hatching season is between November to April. Of the six species of sea turtles found in Australian waters, three species are found around Lady Elliot Island.

This is the are in central Australia around Alice Springs and including Uluru (Ayers Rock), Kata Tjuta (The Olgas) and Wartarrka (Kings Canyon) This area consists of the red earth of the desert landscape in this region.
